 - Independent process- you will learn about yourself!

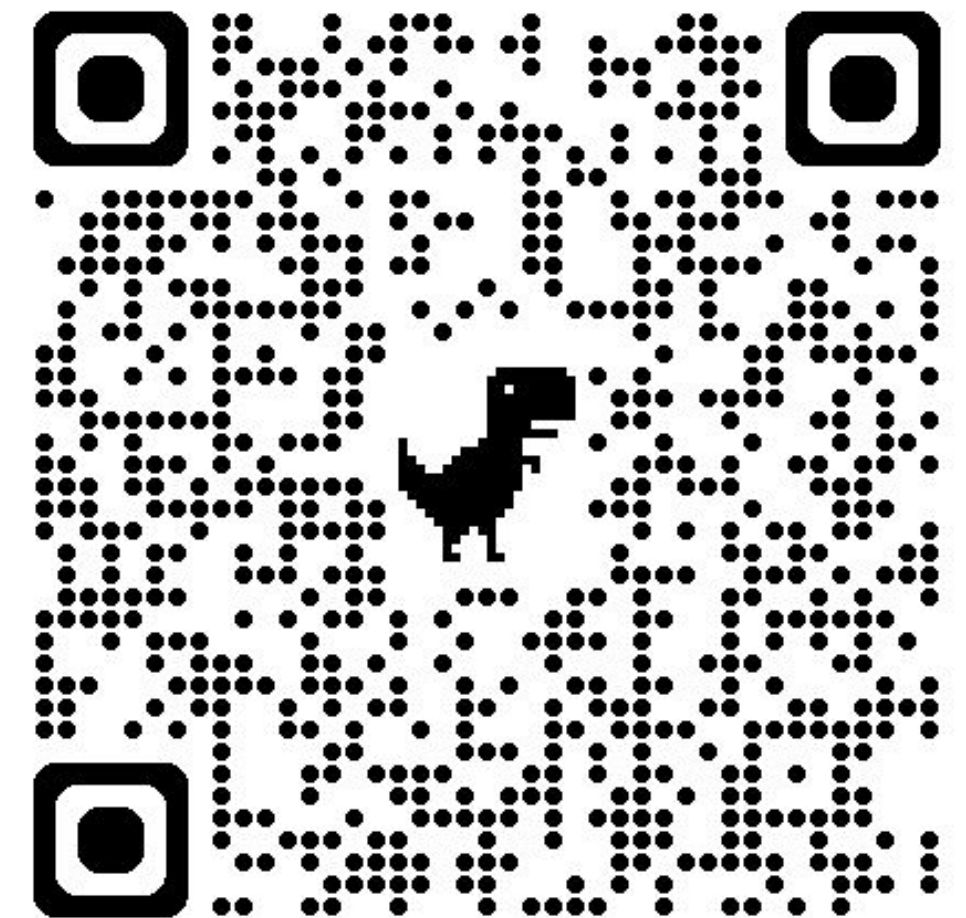
Semester Exchange Overview



Spring Break and May

- Partner School Programs
 - All course work occurs abroad
 - 1-3 weeks
 - Pre-departure orientation and meetings
- Programs are recurring and new each year!
- Cost: \$500-\$900
 - *Does not include airfare*

BBA Short-Term Programs



- Most U-M Financial Aid packages can still apply to short-term and semester exchange programs.
- Apply for Ross Funding Award in M-Compass Application.
- Explore U-M Funding and External Funding opportunities.
- Michigan Educational Trust (MET) or other state-sponsored tuition trust funds
