Criteria and Application Outline

Criteria:

- Enrolled full-time (9+ credits) MAcc student at the University of Michigan's Ross School of Business.
- High academic achievement.
- Financial need as demonstrated by a completed current year Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with the University of Michigan – Ann Arbor campus at the time of application
- Past record of community service.
- Future commitment to serving the Ross School as an alumni.

Application Requirements:

1. Prepare a personal statement addressing the following three questions. 300-word count maximum per question, and no more than one-page, single-spaced per question.
 - How have you demonstrated a commitment to community service outside of the Ross School?
 - When you become an alumna/alumnus, how do you see yourself serving the Ross School Community?
 - What are some new and innovative ways that future alumni can support the school and the overall student experience at Ross?
2. Current Resume.
